- SPARE BATTERIES for radio, phone etc.
- FIRST AID KIT including sunscreen

- CHARGERS phone chargers, camera chargers, iPad chargers
- TENT it's not camping without it
- INFLATABLE MATTRESSES unless you are happy to sleep on the floor
- ESKY store all your cold food in an esky and use large containers to keep your dry food safe on the ride
- TABLES & CHAIRS for cooking and eating al fresco
- FUEL AND A BBQ some campsites have BBQ's but many people prefer to bring their own
